```
#include <stdio.h>
```

```
int main ()  
{
```

```
    int x = 2;
```

```
    int y = 3;
```

```
    int z = 4;
```

```
    printf ("w=%d, x=%d, y=%d, z=%d\n",  
            z, y, x, z);
```

```
    return 0;
```

```
}
```

1. does not compile, as w not defined
2. w=???, x=2, y=3, z=4 where ??? is some unknown number
3. w=4, x=2, y=3, z=4
4. w=4, x=3, y=2, z=4
5. something else

What is printed by the following program?

```
#include <stdio.h>
```

```
int f (int x)
{
    return x*x;
}
```

```
int main ()
{
    int x = 2;
    int t = 5;
    int r = f(t);
    printf ("%d    %d\n", f(x), r);

    return 0;
}
```

1. 4 4

2. x x

3. 4 25

4. f(t) not defined, so
does not compile

5. f defined or used
improperly, so does
not compile

What is printed by the following program?

```
#include <stdio.h>
```

```
void f (int x)
{
    printf (" %d", x*x);
    printf (" %d", x*x*x);
    return;
}
```

```
int main ()
{
    int t= 2;
    int s;
    s = f(t);
    printf (" %d\n", s);

    return 0;
}
```

1. 4 8
2. 4 8 #%!@%%#
3. t tt ttt
4. return error in f, so does not compile
5. s = f(t) error, so does not compile

A program is to be written to compute the sum

$$1*1 + 3*3 + 5*5 + 7*7 + 9*9$$

the desired output is

the sum is 165

A function is to compute the square of a number, so the main program will be

```
int main ()
{
    int sum = func(1) + func(3)
              + func(5) + func(7)
              + func(9);
    printf ("the sum is %d\n", sum);

    return 0;
}
```

Three attempts for the function are given in 09-func-2.c
